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The meeting started on time, the coordinator welcomed all the participants and introduced the agenda of the meeting. The rationale of the meeting was to assess the state of the art of the activities related to the delivery of the modernized courses, the delivery of the New Master in Fintech, and finally the accreditation processes for the missing Universities. Crucial part of the meeting was focused on the existing lacks and weaknesses related to the project results in order to plan the best contingency measures.

Philippines Fintech Association coordinated the meeting sharing the scoreboard excel file.

Jove Tapiador asked to each Asian University to provide and update on the missing numbers and information. All partners will provide an official University document to certify the approval/authorization of the modernized courses. Each university will be free to provide the most suitable declaration (in English). Documents related to the accreditation process should be provided as well.

All the Asian partners committed to make any effort in order to maximize the TRUST results, in particular:

- boosting the activity of the enrolled students in the Platform;

- boosting the promotion of the New accredited Master in Fintech

- accelerating the accreditation processes (where applicable)

- boosting project dissemination and exploitation

In order to support the maximization of project results, Dr. Jove Tapiador as leader of dissemination, will support each Asian university at individual level.

FPA, HCE and MAPUA will join the Erasmus + event at the end of November to reinforce the dissemination of project results and enlarge the network for the exploitation of results.

According to the project proposal, SLU and VNU as WP4 leaders are in charge for the reporting of the activities. In the Piloting Report will be highlighted the additional values of the WP4 partners' activities as the bachelor programme and the exploitation agreements.
